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**AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J. (ORAL)**

By this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR no.0091 dated 03.07.2019, registered at Police Station Phase 11, District S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali), for the alleged commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 452, 323, 341 and 506 of the IPC (with Section 458 of the IPC having been added later), on the basis of a compromise arrived at between them and respondents no.2 and 3. They also seek quashing of all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom. A copy of the compromise deed has been annexed as Annexure P-2 with the petition.

Pursuant to the order dated 22.07.2021, the report of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mohali, dated 10.08.2021, is on record, stating to the effect that the petitioners as also respondents no. 2 and 3 got recorded their statements before that court, to the effect that the matter has been compromised between them, with the statement of the investigating

officer also having been recorded to the effect that there is no other person involved in the occurrence and that there is no other criminal case registered against the petitioners.

As per the assessment of that court, the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and voluntary.

An affidavit has also been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, dated 05.10.2021, which is ordered to be taken on record.

In the affidavit it has also been stated by the DSP, City-2, SAS Nagar, that there is no other FIR registered against the petitioners.

That being so, also looking at the nature of offences involved, with the matter having been amicably settled between the parties, the petition is allowed and FIR no.0091 dated 03.07.2019, registered at Police Station Phase 11, District S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali), for the alleged commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 452, 323, 341 and 506 of the IPC (with Section 458 of the IPC having been added later), along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
