Though matters were being taken up through physical hearing mode today, this matter has been taken up through video conferencing on specific request of learned counsel and in terms of circular dated 14.09.2021.

Prayer in this application is for permission to the petitioner to withdraw this writ petition in view of communication dated 16.07.2021, received by her from the office of District Defence Services Welfare Officer, Faridkot, pursuant to her application dated 22.12.2020, whereby petitioner had sought consideration of her case for cash payment in lieu of two acres of land.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State, on instructions from Col. Jarnail Singh, Deputy Director (Monitoring), Directorate of Defence Services Welfare, Punjab, informs that petitioner's case for cash payment in lieu of two acres of land, is under consideration and shall be decided in

accordance with law.

Keeping in this view the facts and circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner seeks to withdraw this writ petition seeking allotment of ten acres of agricultural land and one residential plot of 10 Marlas and wishes to pursue her claim *qua* cash payment in lieu of two acres of land.

At request and with consent of learned counsel for the parties, this writ petition which stands admitted, is taken on board for hearing today itself.

Keeping in view the above, CM-12160-CWP of 2021 is allowed and CWP No. 1853 of 2008 is dismissed as withdrawn. Needless to say, in case, petitioner is aggrieved of the decision of the authorities in respect to cash payment in lieu of two acres of land, she is at liberty to impugn the same, though, she would not have any right to agitate her claim for allotment of 10 acres of land and 10 Marla residential plot.
