Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.46 dated 16.05.2021, under Sections 406, 498-A and 342 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sri Hargobindpur, Batala.

Vide order dated 20.07.2021, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that pursuant to order dated 20.07.2021, the petitioners have joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 opposes the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Amrik Singh, endorsed that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 20.07.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
