This is a petition that has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.57, dated 10.03.2021, registered under Sections 304-B, 498-A, 34 of IPC at Police Station Dujana, District Jhajjar.

The aforesaid FIR was registered at the instance of Jagbir Singh, who married his daughter (since deceased) with petitioner No.1 in the year 2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioners would contend that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

On the other hand, counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant does not oppose the grant of regular bail to the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Surinder Kumar, states that the matter has been investigated and challan has been presented.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Keeping in view the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties, no useful purpose would be served in keeping the petitioners behind the bars any longer.

Accordingly, the instant petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate. However, any observation made herein shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on merits of the case.
