The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for transferring the complaints/representations dated 20.07.2020 and 04.03.2021 respectively (Annexure P-1 and P-2) filed by the petitioner from Mohali Police to any other agency of Punjab Police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite representations/complaints dated 20.07.2020 and 04.03.2021 having been made to the authorities concerned, no action has been taken by the official respondents. She submits that petitioners would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to the official respondents to look into the aforementioned complaints/representations submitted by her and take appropriate action under the provisions of law.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed by the learned counsel for the petitioner, respondents No. 4-Senior Superintendent of Police, District S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali, Punjab is directed to look into the complaint dated 20.07.2020 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner and take appropriate steps/action, if any, required under the provisions of law expeditiously.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
