By this writ petition, the petitioner had claimed that due to some delay
in the banking procedure, the E-BRCs with respect to the export proceeds of the
petitioner could not be uploaded in time and on that score his claim for MEIS was
declined.

In this connection, the petitioner had moved an application dated 10.11.2020 (Annexure P-5) in terms of clause 2.58 of the Foreign Trade Policy 2015-2020 for grant of exemption/relaxation but despite the lapse of more than one year, the same was not decided.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent has very fairly stated that if the application was filed, that should have been decided and states that now the same shall be decided in any reasonable time fixed by this Court.

In the circumstances, we dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the respondent to decide the application dated 10.11.2020 (Annexure P-5) by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and if the petitioner found entitled to his relief, grant to the same also within the said period.
