This 2nd petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.101 dated 11.06.2021 under Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 and Sections 147, 149, 186, 323, 353, 332, 506 and 341 IPC, registered at Police Station Bhattu Kalan, District Fatehabad.

Vide order dated 27.08.2021 passed by this Court, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 27.08.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Mahender Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 27.08.2021 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
