AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

This is a petition seeking directions to the official respondents to initiate proper enquiry and to take remedial action on the complaint dated 24.5.2021 submitted by the petitioner against respondents No. 5 to 10.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions submits that the complaint was considered. It was found that there are counter allegations levelled by both the parties against each other which were found not to be correct. She further submits that as per the MLR, there are simple injuries inflicted by the blunt weapon. No case is made out for cognizable offence, hence no FIR is registered. She further submits that the petitioner can, on any working day, get copy of the enquiry report from the concerned police station.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of surviving grievances.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State, no further directions are called for.

The petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for by learned counsel for the petitioner.
