1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 05.04.2021, in CWP-6437-2021.
3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that on 27.07.2021, the respondents have circulated copy of order dated 26.07.2021, passed in compliance of order Annexure P/1 dated 05.04.2021, in CWP-6437-2021, therefore, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioners to challenge order dated 26.07.2021, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the respondent having passed order dated 26.07.2021, there is sufficient compliance of order dated 05.04.2021 in CWP No. 6437-2021, therefore no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is warranted against the respondent. Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioners to challenge order dated 26.07.2021, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.
