Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This Criminal Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been moved by petitioner for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner at the hands of private respondents and to take action on representations dated 12.04.2021 and 10.07.2021 (Annexures P-4 and P-5).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representations on 12.04.2021 and 10.07.2021 to Director General of Police, Punjab and Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, copy of which are available on the file as Annexures P/4 and P/5, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3 – Senior Superintendent of Police, District Kapurthala, to look into and decide representation dated 10.07.2021 (Annexure P/5) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
