The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.170 dated 12.05.2021 under Sections 324 and 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Dera Bassi, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant has opposed the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner by urging that the petitioner is the mother-in-law of the complainant and had been taunting her daughter-in-law i.e. the complainant for getting only an Alto Car and not a big car.

However, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mewa Singh, has apprised the Court that in compliance of order dated 06.08.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and submitted that her custodial interrogation is not required in the case.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 06.08.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
