Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 31 dated 09.04.2021, under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Women, District Amritsar.

By virtue of the order dated 22.07.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the parties have submitted that the mediation did not remain successful.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the fact of petitioner's joining investigation and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the same, the interim order dated 22.07.2021, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
