By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail' under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., upon FIR no.129, dated 26.03.2020, having been registered at Police Station Old Sabzi Mandi, District Rohtak, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under Section 306 of the IPC read with Section 34 thereof, with Section 498-A of the IPC added later.

The trial still not having progressed much as per instructions of both learned counsel, with the petitioner not stated to have misused the concession of interim bail granted to him, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed, with the interim order passed on 29.09.2020, at the stage when the petitioner had been in custody for about

5 months, is made absolute.

If the reply filed on behalf of the respondent State has not already been taken on record, it is ordered to be taken on record.
