The petitioners herein seek the quashing of the FIR bearing No.039 dated 08.03.2021 registered at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar Rural, under Sections 304, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).
