Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to not to arrest the petitioner by visiting her house.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that FIR No.212 was registered under Section 21 of the NDPS Act in the year 2020 against one Sukhdev Singh from whom 1.00 Kg of Heroin was recovered and Jaswinder Singh, husband of the present petitioner. It is further submitted that husband of the petitioner has not been arrested so far and in that connection, the police is harassing the petitioner without giving any notice in writing.

Counsel for the State has, however, submitted that since the husband of the petitioner is an accused in a case registered under the NDPS Act, thus, as and when the police received information about his movement, they visited the house of the petitioner, just to arrest the husband of the petitioner i.e. Jaswinder Singh and the present petitioner is not involved in the aforesaid FIR.

Since the police is performing its duty in accordance with law, no further action is called for.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
