ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (Oral)

This is the first petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.51 dated 2.5.2021 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for the last about three months and the investigation is complete and the challan stands presented. It is also submitted that the allegations against the petitioner are that the GST number was used by co-accused Abhishek Goyal for the purpose of making some business transactions with the complainant.

Learned State counsel, assisted by counsel for the complainant and on the basis of the affidavit of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, has not disputed the factual position. It is also not disputed that the investigation is complete and the challan stands presented.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, considering the fact that the offence is triable by the Court of Magistrate and it will take some time in its conclusion of the trial, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail, subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate, concerned.
