1. Through this writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the order (Annexure P-18) on various grounds including that it has been passed in violation of principles of natural justice.

2. We put it to learned counsel whether appeal is maintainable against the abovesaid order. He though accepts that the appeal is maintainable yet it is his contention that there has been such flagrant violation of law that this petition should be allowed to proceed and that in similar cases various High Courts have interfered. He, however, accepted that all the contentions which he is raising can be raised before the Appellate Authority.

3. In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed being not maintainable at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to file an appeal in accordance with law.

4. Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Miscellaneous Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
