The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* by directing the respondents to count the entire daily wage services of the petitioner rendered before regularization as qualifying service for the purposes of pensionary/retiral benefits and further he be held entitled to receive pensionary benefits as per the old GPF scheme as per settled law.

Heard.

In the light of oral submissions of the petitioner side the directions are issued to respondents to duly consider the case of the petitioner as per settled law and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.
