[1] Learned counsel for the respondents state that in view of the advertisement for the post of Sub Inspector in the Punjab Police *qua* which the writ petition was filed having been withdrawn by the Government of Punjab, the writ petition does not survive and may be disposed of as having become infructuous.

[2] None is present on behalf of the petitioner. For that matter, none was present on behalf of the petitioner on 15.11.2021. In the circumstances, it is apparent that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the writ petition.

[3] Accordingly, in the circumstances, the writ petition is *disposed of* as having become infructuous, while granting liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the instant petition, if cause survives.
