Seen the report sent by former Chief Justice Virender Singh, who was appointed Mediator in the connected case, by this Court on 21.09.2021.

2. It transpires that the matter has been amicably resolved between the complainant and the petitioners.

3. The complainant happens to be the wife of petitioner no.1 and both of them after seven rounds of mediation have agreed to again reside together, as can be seen from the joint compromise/amicable settlement deed signed by both of them along with their other family members.

4. Ld. Mediator has separately sent an intimation dated 02.12.2021 in an envelope to the effect that he has already received his mediation fees from the petitioners by way of cheque.

5. Ld. counsel appearing for both sides are *ad idem* that in the circumstances and in the interest of both the parties as well as their minor child, the present proceedings instituted against the petitioners at the instance of the complainant, should not continue.

6. Consequently, the present petition is dismissed and FIR No.0093, dated 13.08.2021, under Sections 406, 498-A, 506, 34 and 354 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Women, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana and all the proceedings arising out of the same, are ordered to be quashed in view of the compromise arrived at between the parties.

CRWP No.6741 of 2021

In view of the quashing of the FIR, the present petition is sought to be withdrawn by the Ld. counsel for the petitioner.

In view of above, present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
