The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

As per the office report, notice issued to the respondent has been received back served, however, neither the respondent nor his counsel has entered appearance to contest the petition.

On 11.08.2021, the following order was passed:-

“The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This is wife's petition under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking the transfer of petition, bearing No.HM174 dated 17.03.2020 filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as 'Manish Kumar Vs. Diksha' from the Court of District Judge, Family Court, SBS Nagar to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana.

It is prayed that that the aforesaid petition be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana where application under Section 125 Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioner is already pending. The distance between Ludhiana and SBS Nagar is stated to be 70 KMs.

The petitioner shall be at liberty to serve the respondent through his counsel Sh. T.R. Dutta, Advocate at the Court Complex, Balachaur.”

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the petition is allowed.

The petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing No.HM174 dated 17.03.2020, titled as “Manish Kumar Vs. Diksha” is ordered to be transferred from the Court of District Judge (Family Court), SBS Nagar to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana.

The parties through their counsel are directed to appear before the Court of learned District Judge, Ludhiana on 07.09.2021.

The transferor Court is requested to remit the case file to the transferee Court forthwith.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
