The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner has sent a scanned copy of the summons, perusal whereof shows that the summons were received by Sh. H. Suman, Advocate.

On 12.08.2021, the following order was passed:-

“The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This petition has been filed by the wife seeking the transfer of the divorce petition bearing No.HMA/644/2018 ,titled as “Joginder Singh @ Sunny vs. Gurmeet Kaur” pending in the Court of District Judge, Family court, SBS Nagar to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana. The petitioner claims that she got married to the respondent on 18.11.2007 and they were blessed with two male children and one female child. She claims that, at present, she is residing with her parents at Ludhaina and cannot properly defend the petition at SBS Nagar.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner places reliance on the litigation pending in the Court of District Judge, Family Court, Ludhiana, under Section 125 Cr.P.C. bearing No.MNT/2134/2019. He further contends that the distance between the two places is 60 Kms and it is difficult for the petitioner to travel on each date of hearing.

The liberty is granted to the petitioner to serve the

respondent through his counsel Sh. Harmesh Suman and Raj Kumar Malla, at District Courts, SBS Nagar. Dasti also.”

In the absence of the contesting party, the application is allowed, for the reasons recorded in order dated 12.08.2021.

The divorce petition bearing No.HMA/644/2018, titled as “Joginder Singh @ Sunny Vs. Gurmeet Kaur”, pending in the Court of District Judge, Family Court, SBS Nagar, is ordered to be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana.

The petitioner through her counsel is directed to appear before the Court of learned District Judge, Ludhiana, on 08.09.2021.

The transferor Court is requested to remit the case file to the transferee Court forthwith.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
