Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct fair and proper investigation in case i.e. FIR No.57 dated 04.05.2021 registered under Sections 325, 326, 324, 341, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Section 307 IPC added subsequently vide G.D. No.38 dated 04.06.2021) at Police Station City Budhlada, District Mansa.

Counsel for the State has submitted that initially the FIR was registered under Sections 325, 326, 324, 341, 323, 148, 149 IPC and 04 persons namely Pushwinder Singh, Rakesh Kumar, Navjeet Singh @ Vicky and Sandeep Singh @ Hunny i.e. respondents No.5 to 8, were arrested and released on bail. Later on, Section 307 IPC was added vide G.D. No.38 dated 04.06.2021 and the police is taking all measures to arrest Kulwinder Singh @ Gaggi/respondent No.4 and for the said purpose, the arrest warrants have already been obtained from the Illaqa Magistrate. It is further submitted that the FIR is dated

04.05.2021 and it is not a case where the police is lacking its duty in arresting the accused as some of the accused have already been arrested.

In view of the above, I find no ground to issue any further direction to the police.
