This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Prayer in this revision petition is for expeditious conclusion of the execution proceedings pending before the learned District Judge, Amritsar.

It is submitted that compensation of Rs. 34,30,742/- along with interest of 7.5% was awarded to the petitioner along with proforma respondents no. 5 to 8 vide award dated 08.01.2020, by the learned Motor Accident Claim Tribunal, Amritsar. However, respondents, it is submitted are trying to delay the proceedings and are not depositing the amount in question.

Though, notice of motion has not been issued, Ms. Anita Balyan, Advocate, to whom an advance copy of the revision petition has been supplied informs that discrepancy in calculations has crept in due to which an application has been filed before the learned executing Court. It is

submitted that there is no delay on the part of the respondents and there shall be an earnest endeavour for conclusion of the proceedings on 06.10.2021 i.e., the date fixed before the learned executing Court.

In this view of the matter, no order is required to be passed in this revision petition, at this stage. Needless to say, the matter would be considered by the learned executing Court in accordance with law.

Revision petition is accordingly disposed of.
