1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 482Cr.P.C. is for directing respondent Nos.2 & 3 to take appropriate legal action in accordance with law against respondent No.4 in case FIR No.16 dated 19.02.2021 registered under Sections 3(1)(X) of the SC & ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 at Police Station Bhandson, Tehsil Nabha, District Patiala as despite lapse of more than 05 months, no action has been taken, till date.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Hittan Nehra, learned Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice and on instructions from ASI Gurpreet Singh, states that DSP, Nabha vide report dated 21.07.2021 has recommended cancellation of the FIR and the same has been approved by the SSP, Patiala and report in respect thereto

would be filed before the learned trial Court within a few days.

5. Faced with the aforementioned situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to take out appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law on filing of the cancellation report before the learned trial Court.

6. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *dismissed as withdrawn* with the liberty, as prayed for.
