[1] Prayer in the petition under Sections 11 & 12, Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order dated 29.01.2021 in CWP No.1066 of 2021.

[2] Learned counsel contends that CWP No.1066 of 2021 was disposed of vide order (Annexure P-3) dated 29.01.2021, by directing the respondent to decide the legal notice dated 28.10.2020 by passing a speaking order within three months from the date of receipt of copy of the order and in case the petitioners were found entitled to any relief, to release the same to them within two month thereafter.

[3] Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to the filing of the instant petition, the respondent has, decided the claim made in the legal notice and also released benefits to the petitioners as per their entitlement, therefore, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

[4] I have considered the submissions of learned Counsel.

Notice has yet to be issued in the matter. However, in view of the needful having been done in terms of the orders of this Court dated 29.01.2021 in CWP No.1066 of 2021 and benefits released to the petitioners as per their entitlement, I am of the view that there being substantial compliance with the orders, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against the respondent. Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as such.
