The matter has been taken up through video conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic.

Petitioners-M/s Lakshmi Rice Mills through its partner Sarabjit Singh, has filed the present writ petition *inter alia* with a prayer for directing the respondent Nos. 2, 3 and 7 to conduct the physical verification of the available stocks of the paddy/rice and to accept the resultant rice milled by the petitioner on behalf of respondent Nos.6 and 8 in terms of the Custom Milling Policy of the Government of Punjab (Annexure P-1).

In response thereto, short reply on behalf of respondents No.6 and 8 has been filed. Written statement on behalf of respondents No.1, 2, 3 and 7 has also been separately filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the substantive relief as prayed in the writ petition has been granted to the petitioner. He further submits that no further orders are called for.
