The grievance of the petitioner in the present Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is that she has put in 30 years as a Class-4 employee with respondent No.4-Corporation. However, despite having put 30 years of service and despite having given various representations, her case has not been considered for regularization.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that in this regard a legal notice dated 28.07.2020 (Annexure P-8) was also served upon the respondents. However, till date no decision has been taken qua the same. Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to take a decision on the legal notice dated 28.07.2020 (Annexure P-8) in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sehajbir Singh, Advocate has accepted notice on behalf of the respondents.

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.4 - Sub Divisional Engineer, PSPCL, Bhikhi, District Mansa - to take a decision on the legal notice dated 28.07.2020 (Annexure P-8) expeditiously, in accordance with law, and in any case within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Disposed off accordingly.
