This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing respondent No. 2 to issue Arms Licence to the petitioner in pursuance of the application dated 17.05.2021 (Annexure P3) within a fixed time frame in accordance with the procedure prescribed under the law.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has already moved a representation dated 17.05.2021 (Annexure P3) requesting for issuance a new gun licence; which is still pending before the concerned authorities and the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents take a conscious decision on the same and pass a speaking order thereon, within a time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Additional AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Even counsel for the respondents is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide representation dated 17.05.2021 (Anneuxre P3) of the petitioner and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order; within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
