The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

By this order two transfer applications i.e TA-620-2021 and TA-626-2021, filed by the petitioner (wife of the respondent) shall stand disposed of.

In TA-620-2021, the petitioner (wife) prays for transfer of petition under Section 6 of the Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act, 1956 read with the provisions of the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890, from the Court of District Judge (Family Court) Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar to the court of competent jurisdiction at Jalandhar.

Admittedly, the petitioner is residing at Phillaur. The distance between Phillaur and Jalandhar and between Phillaur and Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar is the same i.e 30 kms. The respondent (husband) is maintaining the minor daughter of the couple. Since the petitioner has to travel the same distance to attend the court proceedings even if her prayer for transfer is accepted, therefore, it would not be appropriate to transfer the petition, as prayed for.

Hence, TA-620-2021 is dismissed.

In TA-626-2021, the petitioner prays for transfer of the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 from the Family Court, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar to the court of competent jurisdiction at Jalandhar.

For the reasons stated above, TA-626-2021 is also held to be without any merit and the same is also dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
