Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.112 dated 16.06.2021 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 506 IPC at Police Station Shahzadpur, District Ambala.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner – Subham as well as his mother Parveen Kaur, have suffered head injuries, which were declared grievous by the doctor. It is further submitted that though the injuries were dangerous to life, however, till date the police is not seeking opinion of the doctor and is not conducting the investigation as to whether the offence under Section 307 IPC is made or not.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has argued that the out of 08 accused persons, 07 have already been arrested and they were released on bail. It is also submitted that as per the medical record, 02 persons namely Subham

and Parveen Kaur have suffered grievous head injury.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.

The SHO, Police Station Shahzadpur, District Ambala, is directed to produce both the victims namely Subham and Parveen Kaur, before the Board of Doctors, to be constituted by the Civil Surgeon, Government Hospital, Ambala, for seeking the opinion as to whether the head injuries sustained by them, was dangerous to life or not.

On receiving such opinion, further action will be taken, in accordance with law.

Needful be done within a period of 03 weeks from today.
