The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

This is the first petition filed by the petitioner under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.52, dated 21.05.2021 registered for offence under Sections 22 and 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Arniwala, Tehsil and District Fazilka, Punjab.

State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh, submits that the FSL report has been received. As per his instructions, 1800 tablets of Clevedol (100 SR) were recovered from the *dicky* of vehicle, which was being driven by the petitioner. He submits that the weight of the contraband recovered works out to 582 grams of tramadol, which falls within the ambit of commercial quantity, as per the Notification issued under the provisions of the NDPS Act.

Having argued the matter for sometime and realizing that the Court is not inclined to agree with his submissions, counsel for the petitioner prays and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
