B.S. Walia, J. (Oral)

1. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court, to move a petition for regular bail and directions being issued to the learned trial Court to consider and decide the petition for regular bail, in a time bound manner.

2. The same is not opposed to by learned State counsel.

3. Accordingly, in the light of statement of learned counsel for the parties but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty as prayed for. In the eventuality of the petitioner moving a petition for regular bail before the learned trial Court, the learned trial Court is directed to consider and decide the same as expeditiously as possible preferably within one week, in accordance with law by taking into account all aspects of the matter.
