Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioners are seeking quashing of DDR No.31 dated 04.06.2021, under Sections 452, 323, 326, 379, 506, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines Batala, District Gurdaspur in FIR No.107 dated 04.06.2021 registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala, on the basis of compromise dated 30.06.2021 (Annexure P-3), which has been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the incident is outcome of a sudden quarrel between the residents of the same village. It is a case of version and cross-version and there were injuries on both the sides. All the injured have fully recovered from the injuries and the matter has now been compromised. He has referred to the copy of the compromise at Annexure P-3.

This Court by the order dated 27.07.2021 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to this Court. The report of JMIC, Batala, dated 25.08.2021 has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that the compromise is genuine and without any coercion or undue influence.

The incident is outcome of a sudden quarrel between the residents of the same village, which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised.

In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466*, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and DDR No.31 dated 04.06.2021, under Sections 452, 323, 326, 379, 506, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines Batala, District Gurdaspur in FIR No.107 dated 04.06.2021 registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner(s).
