This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

It is pleaded that petitioners are residents of Maharaja Yadvindra Enclave, Nabha Road, Patiala.

Counsel submits that the afore-described residential colony comes under the control of Improvement Trust, Patiala.

Instant writ petition has been filed raising a grievance that an iron gate has been installed on a 20 Feet wide road leading to the plots of the petitioners and thereby forcing the petitioners to resort to an alternate route.

Precise contention is that such iron gate is without due permission from the authority concerned.

Counsel has also adverted to memo dated 01.01.2020 appended as Annexure P-6 whereby in response to an application filed under the provisions of the Right to Information Act, the Assistant Public Information

Officer, Improvement Trust, Patiala has informed petitioner No.1 herein that the office i.e. Improvement Trust, Patiala has not given any approval for installation of a gate upon the internal passages of the scheme (Maharaja Yadvindra Enclave).

It is further asserted that inspite of repeated representations having been made no action has been taken.

Having heard counsel at length, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition at the very threshold without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made therein with a direction to respondent No.2/competent authority to examine the grievance of the petitioners against the backdrop of a legal notice dated 21.05.2021 (Annexure P-7) that is stated to have already been served and to thereafter take steps, if any, as warranted in accordance with law.
