This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the qualifying service rendered by the petitioners for the purpose of pension from the date of their appointment and to pay the revised pension and arrears of revised pension along with interest.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioners submits that, at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied if the respondents take a conscious decision on the legal notices of the petitioners dated 1.4.2021 and 15.4.2021 (Annexure P-3 and P-4) and pass a speaking order thereon, within a time frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Rathee, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Even counsel for the respondents is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioners.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a

direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notices of the petitioners dated 1.4.2021 and 15.4.2021 (Annexure P-3 and P-4) and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order; within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that if the petitioners are found entitled to any pecuniary benefits upon such a conscious decision; then the said pecuniary benefits shall also be released to the petitioners within a further period of 3 months; from the date of such conscious decision of the authorities.
