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M/s Punjab Rolling Mills filed a complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act against M/s Swaran Foundary, Nangal (Khera) & Anr. alleging that a cheque issued by the petitioner-accused in the sum of Rs.4,96,077/- dated 12.06.2013 in favour of the complainant was dishonored. The learned Trial Magistrate after a consideration of the matter found the accused persons guilty and sentenced respondent-Lashkari Ram to undergo R.I. and to pay a compensation of Rs.4,96,077/- i.e. the cheque amount. The appeal thereagainst was dismissed by the learned Additional District Judge, Kapurthala. Hence, this revision petition at the instance of the accused person.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the parties have entered into a compromise and in terms of the said compromise, the amount has been paid to the complainant-respondent No.1. Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.1 admitted the factum of the compromise before the Court and submitted that he has no objection in case the sentence of the petitioner is set aside.

Mr. Gaurav Garg Dhuriwala, Sr. DAG, Punjab has appeared before us and he has no objection if the conviction and sentence is set aside.

On a consideration of it and keeping in view the compromise, the conviction and sentence is set aside. The revision petition is allowed. File be consigned to record.
