By this petition, the petitioner seeks a direction to respondent no.4 to take appropriate legal action on the General Diary Report bearing no.29 dated 13.04.2021 (Annexure P-2), submitted by respondent no.3 (the SHO, P.S.Baibowal) and to decide his representation dated 06.05.2021 (Annexure P-5) given to respondent no.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage the petitioner is only pressing for a direction to respondent no.4, i.e. the Civil Surgeon, Ludhiana, to give her/his opinion in terms of the matter referred to her/him by the SHO, Police Station Haibowal, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana, as noted in the General Diary Report dated 13.04.2021 (copy Annexure P-2).

He has of course taken this court to the basic facts of the case, to the effect that the petitioner is aggrieved of the death of his father, allegedly due to gross negligence at the hands of some doctors in a private hospital.

Consequently, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Civil Surgeon, Ludhiana (respondent no.4), to give her/his opinion, (such opinion having been sought by the SHO, as contended; absolutely fearlessly and correctly within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, with the matter already having remained pending with the Civil Surgeon for about 3 months as contended.
