Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution for issuance of directions to the respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members and to hand over the keys of the house, situated at Dashmesh Colony, Gali No.3, Near Chintpurni Mandir, Narotam Vihar, Kapurthala, belonging to the petitioners, and also to return the household articles allegedly kept by respondent No.3.

In compliance of the order dated 08.02.2021, affidavit of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, has been filed in the Registry. The same is taken on record.

As per the affidavit, the household articles recovered in the present case, vide recovery memo dated 05.07.2020 Annexure R-1/T, have been kept in the Malkhana.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners wants to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the appropriate

forum, in accordance with law, for redressal of their grievance.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
