The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.184 dated 19.09.2016 registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga.

The FIR was registered on 19.09.2016. Petitioner was granted bail vide order dated 03.04.2017 passed in CRM-M No.4032 of 2017. Thereafter, the petitioner absented from the Court. Vide order dated 01.07.2019, he was declared as

proclaimed offender. Petitioner did not surrender of his own, rather he was arrested by the police on 07.01.2020 and since then, he is in custody. Petitioner remained absented from the Court for about 10 months.

As per prosecution case, 900 tablets of Aldix-0.5 Alprazolam were recovered from the petitioner. Initially, the petitioner was arrested on 19.09.2016 and thereafter, he was released on regular bail on 03.04.2017..

Since the petitioner has misused the concession of regular bail, therefore, no indulgence can be granted in favour of the petitioner, particularly when his two earlier petitions have been dismissed as withdrawn on 11.09.2020 and 19.01.2021.

No ground is made out to grant regular bail in favour of the petitioner. The present petition stands dismissed.
