Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No.16 dated 20.01.2019, under Sections 406, 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 506, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Bhondsi, District Gurugram, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2), which has been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is outcome of a monetary dispute which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised. He has referred to the copy of the compromise at Annexure P-2.

This Court by the order dated 28.07.2021 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to this Court. The report of JMIC, Sohna, Gurugram, dated 20.08.2021 has been received,

wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements

of the parties were recorded which indicates that the compromise is genuine and without any coercion or undue influence.

The FIR is outcome of a monetary dispute, which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised.

In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466*, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.16 dated 20.01.2019, under Sections 406, 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 506, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Bhondsi, District Gurugram and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner(s).
