Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing Clause 12 of the appointment order dated 23.09.2014 (P-9), whereby New Defined Contributory Pension Scheme as notified by the Punjab Government, vide Notification dated 02.03.2004 (P-12) has been made applicable to the petitioner.

At the outset, learned Counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the representation dated 28.02.2020 (P-13) is considered and decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the

respondent(s) and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 28.02.2020 (P-13) in accordance with law by passing speaking order preferably within a period of 06 (six) weeks from today.
