LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of pandemic, COVID-19.

Petitioner in this case seeks a direction to the respondents to conclude the inquiry being conducted on his complaint/representation against officials of the Fisheries Department.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the Additional Deputy Commissioner of Police, Palwal, vide communication dated 01.03.2021 (Annexure P3) had directed the officials to remain present for the purpose of inquiry on 18.03.2021, however, no action is being taken.

Mr. Sharan Sethi, Addl. A.G., Haryana, to whom an advance copy of paper book has been supplied, submits that one inquiry has been conducted by the Additional Deputy Commissioner of Police, Palwal and another by the Superintendent of Police, Palwal. No truth is stated to have been found in the complaints submitted by the petitioner. Copy of the reports dated 12.04.2021 and 17.06.2021 have been circulated on the Whatsapp group created for the purpose of video conferencing. Print out of the same be taken and attached with the file.

Admittedly, present writ petition is rendered infructuous and no further orders are called for. However, petitioner is at liberty to avail the remedy/remedies as may be available to him if aggrieved of the said reports.

Present writ petition is disposed of accordingly .
