Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.62 dated 16.04.2019, under Sections 307, 341, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station City-I, Sangrur, District Sangrur.

On 27.07.2021, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had passed the following order:-

“Case taken up through video conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that it is a case of version and cross version and the petitioner himself had suffered two gun shot injuries in the incident. He further submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the investigation and he be permitted to do so.

Notice of motion.

Mr.J.S. Ghuman, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

I find it a fit case to grant interim bail to the petitioner.

As such, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation by contacting the Investigating Officer within seven days from today and render all sort of co-operation. The petitioner is to surrender his passport before the Investigating Officer, if he has got one, otherwise to furnish affidavit in that regard. If in the meanwhile, he is arrested, he be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Be listed on 15.9.2021 along with the connected petition bearing CRMM- 23385-2019.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Pritpal Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 27.07.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
