Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to official respondents to take appropriate action against respondent No.5 on the statement of petitioner dated 18.10.2020 (Annexure P/5) by adding Sections 354 and 452 IPC in cross-case FIR No.74 dated 04.03.2021 under Sections 148, 323, 325 and 506 IPC read with Section 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Focal Point, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that grievance of the petitioner would be redressed in case the instant petition is treated as representation on behalf of the petitioner and if the same is ordered to be disposed of by respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion restricted to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to treat instant petition as representation and to look into and decide the same in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
