This appeal has been filed against the award passed by the
Railway Claims Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench.

Learned counsel for the appellant does not challenge the
correctness of the award passed on merits. He, however, submits that
the Tribunal has erred in splitting the awarded amount into 72
instalments of Rs.10,000/- per month. He submits that the appellant
requires the awarded amount for her medical treatment. The appellant
has not placed on record any evidence to this effect.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to interfere
is made out. Hence, dismissed.
