Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.51 dated 18.5.2021 registered under Section 376 IPC at Police Station Chohla Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

By virtue of the order dated 26.7.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
