1. This order shall dispose of the aforesaid two petitions i.e. CRM-M-29367-2021 filed on behalf of Manmohan Singh & others seeking quashing of FIR No.235 dated 21.05.2021 registered at Police Station Civil Line, Kaithal, under Sections 148/149/324/326 IPC (offence under Section 326 IPC deleted later on) as well as CRM-M-30223-2021 filed on behalf of Sandeep @ Deepu & others

seeking quashing of General Diary Report No.21 dated 22.05.2021 under Sections 148/149/323/506/427 IPC in FIR No. 235 dated 21.05.2021 registered at Police Station Civil Line, Kaithal, under Sections 148/149/324/326 IPC (offence under Section 326 IPC deleted later on) and all other subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

2. Vide orders dated 28.07.2021 in CRM-M-29367-2021 and 02.08.2021 in CRM-M-30223-2021, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Joint report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kaithal has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of accused/petitioners Manmohan Singh, Prabhjot Singh, Amrit Kaur and Vikram Jeet Singh in CRM-M-29367-2021 and accused/petitioners Sandeep @ Deepu, Chander Bhan, Sunil @ Nanu, Sunil @ Silla and Bhupinder Gill in CRM-M-30223-2021 have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.
4. Being cross-cases, both the parties in their joint statement have stated that they have no objection in case the FIR No.235 dated 21.05.2021 and General Diary No.21 dated 22.05.2021 are quashed.
5. The learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kaithal, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion and undue influence.

6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, both the petitions are allowed and FIR No.235 dated 21.05.2021 registered at Police Station Civil Line, Kaithal, under Sections 148/149/324/326 IPC (offence under Section 326 IPC deleted later on) as well as General Diary Report No.21 dated 22.05.2021 under Sections 148/149/323/506/427 IPC in FIR No. 235 dated 21.05.2021 registered at Police Station Civil Line, Kaithal, under Sections 148/149/324/326 IPC (offence under Section 326 IPC deleted later on) as well as all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
