Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

This petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.5 to 10.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that both the petitioners are major and have married against the wishes of respondents No.5 to 10 and have sought protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger at the hands of respondents No.5 to 10. The marriage certificate and the photographs evidencing their marriage are on record as Annexures P-3 and P-4, respectively. Petitioner No.1 has submitted a representation dated 13.07.2021 (Annexure P-6) to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jagraon, District Ludhiana (Rural).

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4-State only.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Avtar Singh Sandhu, Addl. A.G. Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the present petition with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jagraon, District Ludhiana (Rural), to decide the representation dated 13.07.2021 (Annexure P-6) moved by petitioner No.1, and grant protection to the petitioners, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived.

It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.
