The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.46 dated 05.04.2019 under Sections 498-A and 120-B IPC 1860 registered at Police Station Dinanagar District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that it is essentially a matrimonial dispute between the parties, which has resulted in the registration of the FIR in question against him. He further submits that pursuant to order dated 29.11.2019, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the State as well.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Surjit Singh states that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 29.11.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
